# HIGHER EDUCATION OPTIONS...

### **LEVEL 8**

### PhD



#### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

A PhD is the highest level of degree. It involves independent and original research into a specific field or subject – which is used to write a lengthy thesis that's worthy of publication. Most universities will require you to have both a Bachelor's and a Master's degree to get started with a PhD. However, people who only have a Bachelor's degree are often still accepted. This might involve initially registering to study for a Master's, to be upgraded to a PhD partway through studying (based on your progress).

#### PROGRESSION:

A PhD can lead straight into a career

### **LEVEL 7**

### MASTER'S DEGREE

#### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

A Master's degree is the most common type of **postgraduate** qualification and involves a more in-depth level of study than a Bachelor's degree. They're designed to focus on a specific area of a wider subject – and they can either be taught or research based courses. You'll usually need a minimum of a 2:1 at undergraduate level to be accepted onto a Master's course, although those with a 2:2 may be accepted with relevant professional experience.

#### PROGRESSION:

A Master's degree can lead straight into a career or you can continue to do a PhD

### LEVEL 6

### BACHELOR'S DEGREE

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

A Bachelor's degree is the most common type of **undergraduate** degree – and can be studied straight after finishing further education. Entry requirements may vary from course to course – but you'll usually be required to gain a certain number of UCAS points to get started. These can be made up of a variety of Level 3 qualifications, including A levels, BTECs and Diplomas.

#### PROGRESSION:

A Bachelor's degree can lead straight into a career or you can continue to postgraduate education

### LEVEL 5

### FOUNDATION DEGREE

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Although specific entry requirements may vary, entry can be gained through a range of qualifications that are usually studied at school level. These include A Levels or a Level 3 diploma.

### PROGRESSION:

The Foundation Degree - equal to two years at university - can lead straight into a career or be 'topped up' by further to study to become a full Bachelor's degree

### HIGHER NATIONAL DIPLOMA (HND)

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

For this work-related course, entry requirements vary but as a minimum, you will need a relevant Level 3 and/or Level 4 qualification and Maths and English at Grade 4/C or above

### PROGRESSION:

You may be able to progress to the second year of a degree level qualification or into employment

### LEVEL 4

### HIGHER NATIONAL CERTIFICATE (HNC)

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

For this work-related qualification, you will need a relevant Level 3 qualification and a minimum requirement of Maths and English at Grade 4/C or above

### **PROGRESSION**

You may be able to progress to an HND or the second year of a degree level qualification
