

A LEVEL FILM STUDIES

PREPARATION WORK

- Watch a film in a foreign language from a country other than the U.S. or the U.K. make notes on how it is different/similar to U.S./U.K. films
- Watch a documentary film, make notes on how it is different/similar to a fictional film
- Watch 3-5 short films. Make a note of where the film was shown e.g. Amazon, Short of the Week, YouTube and how short films differ to feature films, other than the duration
- Create a drawn storyboard, on paper, of a filmed sequence of 15-25 shots. Try to include a variety of shots, including close-ups
- Create a short film, or sequence, of 15-25 shots using your phone, iPad or video camera if you have access to one. You can edit, add-in music or effects in iMovie or other downloadable free software
