tested positive for COVID-19 (coronavirus)	 Student shouldn't attend school Student self-isolates for at least 10 days from when symptoms* started (or from day of test if no symptoms) Inform College immediately about test results Whole household self-isolates for 10 days from day when symptoms* started (or from day of test if no symptoms) - even if someone tests negative during those 10 days 	when Student feels better, and has been without a fever for at least 48 hours They can return to College after 10 days even if they have a cough or loss of smell / taste. somebody in my household has COVID- 19 (coronavirus) symptoms	 Student shouldn't attend College Household member with symptoms should get a test Whole household self-isolates while waiting for test result Inform College immediately about test results 	when household member test is negative, and Student does not have COVID-19 symptoms Email results to: covid@halesowen.ac.uk	
somebody in my household	 Student shouldn't attend school Whole household self-isolates for 10 days from day when 	when Student has completed 10 days of self-isolation, even if they test negative	

has tested positive for COVID-19 (coronavirus)

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NHS Test and Trace has identified me as a 'close contact' of somebody with confirmed COVID-19 (coronavirus)	 Student shouldn't attend College Student self-isolates for 10 days (as advised by NHS Test and Trace) – even if they test negative during those 10 days Rest of household does not need to self-isolate, unless they are a 'close contact' too 	when the Student has completed 10 days of self-isolation, even if they test negative during those 10 days
I have travelled and have to selfisolate as part of a period of quarantine	 Do not take unauthorised leave in term time Consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel Provide information to College as per attendance policy Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed: Student shouldn't attend College Whole household self-isolates for 10 days – even if they test negative during those 10 days 	when the quarantine period of 10 days has been completed for the Student, even if they test negative during those 10 days
I have received advice from a medical / official source that I must resume shielding	 Student shouldn't attend school Contact College as advised and speak to Personal Coach / Student Support Manager Student should shield until you are informed that restrictions are lifted and shielding is paused again 	when College / other agencies inform you that restrictions have been lifted and the student can return to College again
I am not sure who should get a test for COVID -19 (coronavirus)	 Only people with symptoms need to get a test People without symptoms are not advised to get a test, even if they are a 'close contact' of someone who tests positive 	when conditions above, as matching your situation, are met
