LEARNER SUPPORT FUND (LSF)

If you have a household income of $\pounds 37,398$ or below or someone in the household is in receipt of certain benefits, you could receive financial help to support you with college costs such as meals, uniform, equipment, and childcare. We will need to see evidence of the household income you receive.

All funds are distributed on a needs basis and are subject to affordability. Funds are finite and are allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Funding is available to students studying a course which is funded by the ESFA. You cannot receive this support if you are aged under 16, studying a HE course, Apprenticeship or any other course not funded by the ESFA.

The amount of funding available to you is dependent on your total household income; the thresholds for support are as follows:



Students in Band 1 may get up to 100% of any approved award; Band 2 – 60% and Band 3 – 30%.

The benefits you receive and the number of dependants in the household may also be taken into account when your application is assessed.

WHAT CAN I CLAIM SUPPORT FOR?

Meals

Your college card can be activated with meal credits to spend in Elliott's, Starbucks and Bistro@B63.

Essential equipment and uniform can be funded if it is a requirement for the course.

• Trips & Enrichment

Trips and enrichment can be funded if offered as part of the course.

• Work Placement

if required.

Travel

In extenuating circumstances, transport decided on an individual basis.

Childcare

If you are aged 20 and over, you can apply for support towards Childcare whilst you are attending college. To check for availability at Nursery@B63, please contact 0121 602 7677 or email nursery@halesowen.ac.uk.

VULNERABLE BURSARY

If you are 16-18 years old on 31/08/2021 and one of the following applies to you, you may be able to access a bursary paid weekly, of up to $\pounds1,200$ per year.

- In Care
- Care Leaver
- Receiving Income Support or Universal Credit as the student is living independently or supporting a dependant.
- Receiving both PIP/DLA and ESA/UC in the student's own right

PAYMENTS

Direct payments are only made when a student meets certain eligibility criteria. Any payments made to you will be paid by BACS. **Bank details must be in the student's name.**

We can also make payments in kind. Part time students will be funded on a pro rata basis.

2. **Confirm** your account by clicking the activation link sent to your email.

Please note, if we do not see the correct evidence, your application will be returned, and we will email explaining what we need to see. We will not assess your application until we have the correct evidence.

4. Complete the application form including **uploading evidence** of your **household income**.

5. Agree to the terms and conditions and **submit your application**. You will receive an email to confirm we have received it.
