I have COVID-19 (coronavirus) symptoms	 You shouldn't attend College You should get a PCR test Anyone in household aged over 18 years and 6 months and not fully vaccinated self-isolates while waiting for result Report absence online ASAP Inform College about test results ASAP 	if your PCR test comes back negative and you are well enough Email results to: covid@halesowen.ac.uk
tested positive for COVID-19 (coronavirus)	 You shouldn't attend college Self-isolate for 10 days from when symptoms started (or from day of test if no symptoms). However: This can be reduced to 5 days if you are fully vaccinated and have a negative lateral flow test on the morning of days 5 & 6 Report absence online ASAP Anyone in household aged over 18 years and 6 months and not fully vaccinated self-isolates for 10 days 	when you feel better, and have completed your isolation period You can return to College after isolation even if you have a cough or loss of smell / taste. These symptoms can last for several weeks once the infection is gone. Email results to: covid@halesowen.ac.uk
somebody in my household has COVID- 19 (coronavirus) symptoms	 Continue to attend & lateral flow test for 7 days, unless: If you are aged over 18 years and 6 months and not fully vaccinated then you should self-isolate while waiting for the result Household member with symptoms should get a test 	immediately with 7 day testing orwhen household member test is negative
somebody in my household has tested positive for COVID-19 (coronavirus)	 Continue to attend, and lateral flow test for 7 days, unless: If you are aged over 18 years and 6 months and not fully vaccinated then you should self-isolate for 10 days 	immediately with 7 day testing orwhen you have completed 10 days of self-isolation

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NHS Test and Trace has identified me as a 'close contact' of somebody with confirmed COVID-19 (coronavirus)	 You will need to isolate for 10 days unless you have an exemption: You are fully vaccinated You are aged below 18 years and 6 months You are not able to vaccinate due to medical reasons 	when you have completed 10 days of self-isolation orif an exemption applies, no isolation but lateral flow testing for 7 days
I have travelled and have to selfisolate as part of a government period of quarantine	 Do not take unauthorised leave in term time Consider quarantine requirements and FCO advice when booking travel Provide information to College as per attendance policy Returning from a destination where quarantine is needed: Do not attend College Whole household self-isolates for the period required by government guidance in force at the time 	when the quarantine period in force at the time has been completed
I have received advice from a medical / official source that I must resume shielding	 Do not attend college Contact College asap Learners speak to speak to Student Support Manager Staff speak to Rachael Charles 	when College / other agencies inform you that restrictions have been lifted and you can return to College again
l am not sure who should get a test for COVID -19	 All staff and students should be lateral flow testing twice a week You may need to get a PCR test if the situations in the current guidance apply. 	when conditions above, as matching your situation, are met

Symptoms include at least one of a high temperature; a new continuous cough; a loss of or change to your sense of smell or taste.
