

## Cash for College

### Financial Support for students

Is your household income **£43,680** or less?  
Is your household in receipt of any income benefits?  
16-18 year old and in care or care leaver?

If yes to any of the above, you might be eligible for financial support.

- Weekly Meal allowance - money loaded onto college ID card to be used within college.
- Trips and visits related to your course.
- Equipment and Uniform essential to your course.
- Travel costs – University interviews/open days and work experience.
- 16-18 Vulnerable Students – Weekly payments up to £1,200 an academic year, if you are:
  - Care experienced.
  - Living independently and receiving UC or Income Support.
- 16-19 Care to Learn - Childcare costs.
- 20+ Contribution to Childcare costs.

The household income thresholds for support are as follows:

- **Band 1** - Up to £29,485 - 100% Award
- **Band 2** - £29,486 – £36,038 – 60% Award
- **Band 3** - £36,039 – £43,680 – 30% Award

## Here are some examples of the income evidence that may apply to you:

- **Employment** - P60 2023 or 2x latest monthly payslips/4x weekly payslips
- **Self-Employment** - Tax Return 2023
- **Pension** – 2023 Letter
- **Universal Credit (UC)** - at least 3x latest statements
- **Tax Credit** - 2023/24 Award Letter
- **Income Support** - 2023 Award Letter
- **Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)** - 2023 Letter
- **Income Based Job Seekers Allowance (JSA)** - 2023 Letter
- **Guarantee element of State Pension Credit** - 2023 Letter
- **Housing Benefit** – 2023 Letter
- **Support under part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999** - Copy of both sides of Application Registration Card (ARC card) and ASPEN Card including a recent receipt.
- **16-18 in Care/Care Leaver** - Written confirmation of the student's current or previous looked after statement issued by the Local Authority (email is acceptable).
- **16-18 - Living Independently and receipt of Income Support or Universal Credit because they are financially supporting themselves and/or a dependant** - Income Support or Universal Credit letter because they are financially supporting themselves and/or a dependant.
- **16-18 Students in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Personal Independence Payments (PIP) as well as Employment and Support Allowance or Universal Credit in their own right** - DLA/PIP Letter and UC/ESA Letter.

### Here is the small print:

- Applications cannot be processed without household income evidence.
- All financial support provided is subjected to satisfactory attendance and behaviour.
- Please note that Apprenticeships, HE and Under 16 courses are not funded by Cash for College.
