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LEVEL 1

Your individual needs will be discussed with your Personal Coach during tutorial and communicated to the curriculum staff involved in your learning journey. It may include the following:

- Provision of lesson materials on Moodle.
- Adapted learning strategies and resources within the classroom to support SpLD.
- Use of accessibility software to support a range of individual needs.
- Access to the college counselling service.
- Tutorial with Personal Coach on a regular basis.

LEVEL 2

This will be organised via a referral from your Personal Coach to the learning Support team if you both feel an assessment for additional support is required. This may include everything in level 1 but could also include:

- Access to the support equipment through the Learner Support Fund.
- Additional support from outreach services (Autism Outreach, Specialist Impairment Service etc.), if required.
- Access to a mentor appointment.
- Qualified assessors to complete an assessment for reasonable adjustments for formal examinations (or application with supporting medical evidence).
- Access to a quieter space when needed.

LEVEL 3

This level of support will be provided based upon the specific needs outlined in your Educational Health Care Plan and could include the following in addition to the other levels:

- Transition arrangements.
- Support within the classroom (Covid guidelines pending).
- Personal care.

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
